## **5 Year Statewide Impact**

There are 98 Procurement Technical Assistance Centers (PTACs) - with over 300 local offices – which form a nationwide network of dedicated procurement professionals working to help local businesses compete for contract awards. PTACs are the bridge between buyer and supplier, bringing to bear their knowledge of both contracting in the public & private sectors and the capabilities of contractors to maximize fast, reliable service with better quality and at lower costs.

Established in 1986, the Alabama PTAC provides expert guidance to companies competing for contract awards, subcontracts, and set-asides.

## **Service Delivery Summary:** Impact in 67 Counties

Over the last five years, the Alabama PTAC delivered substantial consulting and training services that have allowed a diverse group of small businesses to compete for and win almost \$1 billion in contracts.

- Consulting client breakdown: 3,595 clients served
  - > 41% Rural
  - > 40% Women
  - > 29% Veterans and Service-Connected Disabled Veterans
  - > 36% Minorities
  - > 2.4% Hispanic
- Training event attendee breakdown: 8,256 training attendees **425** training events were conducted:
  - > 40% Women
  - > 27% Veterans and Service-Connected Disabled Veterans
  - > 36% Minorities
